5 Good Reasons to Partner with us:

1. Habitat Homes are sold at cost to Partner families for an interest-free mortgage.
2. Volunteer labor and material donations help keep the cost of the home much lower than market price.
3. We build homes in partnership with people who are unable to secure a normal bank loan but have good credit scores and the financial ability to pay the mortgage, utilities, and other standard home related expenses.
4. We give a helping hand by reducing the down payment to \$500 in exchange for "sweat equity" hours.
5. We assist qualified Medina County residents find great homes that they can call their own, and it is free to apply.

Qualifying for a home

To build a home with Habitat for Humanity Medina County you need to:

- A. Have a need for decent housing
- B. Desire to partner with Habitat

Your partnership will mean putting in 300 sweat equity hours working on Habitat projects, other families homes or sometimes your home. Everyone over the age of 18 living in the home must complete the sweat equity hours.

You will also attend home education and financial planning classes. Keep in mind this partnership may involve 20-30 hours per month of extra work in addition to your regular employment.

C. Have the ability to pay for a home.

As a homebuyer, it is necessary that you have a steady income history. You may still be considered even if you have a steady income from sources other than employment. Check the chart below to see if your income is within our guidelines.
